8	"(o) Viatical settlement providers licensed under the
9	Viatical Settlements Act as of the effective date of this
10	amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly shall be deemed
11	licensed under this Act. All such providers are required to
12	maintain or come into compliance with all of the license
13	requirements of this Act and to provide evidence to the
14	Director that they are in compliance with item (4) of
15	subsection (k) of this Section, concerning financial
16	responsibility; item (6) of subsection (k) of this Section,

concerning an anti-fraud plan; and subsection (m) of this 1 2 Section, concerning life expectancies no later than the 3 effective date of this Act. Such providers shall not be exempt 4 from the requirements for viatical settlement provider license 5 renewal set forth in subsection (i) of this Section. The first 6 anniversary date for the purpose of license renewal under 7 subsection (i) shall be one year from the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly."; and 8

10 on page 45, line 25, by replacing "(c)" with "(d)"; and

11 on page 47, line 4, by replacing "(d)" with "(e)".
