Amends the Smoke Free Illinois Act. Provides that any person who registers a complaint under the Act must disclose his or her name. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Smoke Free Illinois Act is amended by 5 changing Section 40 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 82/40)

7 Sec. 40. Enforcement; complaints.

8 (a) The Department, State-certified local public health 9 departments, and local law enforcement agencies shall enforce 10 the provisions of this Act and may assess fines pursuant to 11 Section 45 of this Act.

12 Any person may register a complaint with (b) the Department, a State-certified local public health department, 13 14 or a local law enforcement agency for a violation of this Act. A person must disclose his or her name when registering a 15 16 complaint. The Department shall establish a telephone number that a person may call to register a complaint under this 17 18 subsection (b).
