Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section 5 2-3.148 as follows:

- (e) The State Board of Education shall be the agency 3 responsible for providing staff and administrative support to 4 5 the task force.
 - (f) Members of the task force shall receive no compensation for their participation, but may be reimbursed by the State Board of Education for expenses in connection with their participation, including travel, if funds are available.
- (g) The task force shall submit a final report of its 10 11 findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General 12 Assembly on or before January 15, 2010. The task force may 13 submit other reports as it deems appropriate.
- (h) The task force is abolished on January 16, 2010. This 14 15 Section is repealed on January 16, 2010.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 16 17 becoming law.
