Introduced 4/2/2009, by Sen. Donne E. Trotter

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$86,680,000 from the General Revenue Fund (GRF) to the Department of Human Services (DHS) for (i) a 5% cost-of-doing-business increase in rates paid to private sector agencies serving individuals with developmental disabilities and (ii) a benefit package for direct support staff in such private sector. Appropriates \$43,320,000 from GRF to DHS for similar purposes in connection with private sector agencies serving individuals with mental illness. Appropriates additional amounts from GRF to DHS to restore grant funding reserved by the Department during fiscal year 2009, and for other purposes. Effective July 1, 2009.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. In addition to any amounts previously
5 appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$60,000,000, or so
6 much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from
7 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services
8 to fund a full 5% cost-of-doing-business increase in the
9 topline rates paid to private sector agencies serving
10 individuals with developmental disabilities to cover the
11 costs of serving people, including, but not limited to, wages
12 for direct support and non-executive staff.

13 Section 10. In addition to any amounts previously
14 appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$26,680,000, or so
15 much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from
16 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services
17 to fund a contemporary and competitive benefit package for
18 direct support staff in private sector agencies serving
19 individuals with developmental disabilities.

20 Section 15. In addition to any amounts previously
21 appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$30,000,000, or so

1 much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from
2 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services
3 to fund a full 5% cost-of-doing-business increase in the
4 rates paid to private sector agencies serving individuals
5 with mental illness to cover the increased costs of serving
6 people, including, but not limited to, wages for non-
7 executive staff.

8 Section 20. In addition to any amounts previously
9 appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$13,320,000, or so
10 much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from
11 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services
12 to fund a contemporary and competitive benefit package for
13 non-executive staff in private sector agencies serving
14 individuals with mental illness.

15 Section 25. In addition to any amounts previously
16 appropriated for that purpose, the sum of \$8,900,000 is re-
17 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department
18 of Human Services to restore grant funding reserved by the
19 Department during fiscal year 2009.

20 Section 30. The sum of \$39,200,000, or so much of that
21 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
22 Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for the

1 following:

2 (1) To increase the transportation component of the
3 Community Integrated Living Arrangement (CILA) rate,
4 \$18,400,000.

5 (2) For nursing services in Community Integrated Living
6 Arrangements (CILAs), \$6,000,000.

7 (3) To increase the top-line rate for Community
8 Integrated Living Arrangements (CILAs) to provide services
9 and supports for individuals with medical and behavioral
10 challenges, \$6,000,000.

11 (4) To increase reimbursements for transportation
12 services for individuals receiving Developmental Training
13 (DT), \$8,800,000.

14 Section 35. The sum of \$21,900,000, or so much of that
15 amount that may be necessary, is appropriated from the
16 General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for
17 the following:

18 (1) For Medicaid Rehabilitation Option to align contract
19 reimbursement with services being provided, \$16,000,000.

20 (2) To increase capacity grants for non-Medicaid
21 reimbursable services in the Division of Mental Health,
22 \$3,900,000.

23 (3) To increase Community Service Grant Programs for
24 Persons with Mental Illness, \$2,000,000.

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2 2009.
