1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5	thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
6	and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
7	of the Trustees of Southern Illinois University to meet
8	ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
9	June 30, 2010:
10	Payable from the General Revenue Fund:
11	For Personal Services, including payment
12	to the university for personal services
13	costs incurred during the fiscal year
14	and salaries accrued but unpaid to academic
15	personnel for personal services rendered
16	during the 2009-2010 academic year\$210,685,500
17	For State Contributions to Social
18	Security, for Medicare
19	For Group Insurance
20	For Contractual Services
21	For Travel55,200
22	For Commodities
23	For Equipment

1	For Telecommunications Services1,775,400
2	For Operation of Automotive Equipment633,100
3	For Awards and Grants
4	Total \$236,638,400

Section 10. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University for all costs associated with the development, support, or administration of pharmacy practice education or training programs at the Edwardsville campus.

Section 15. The amount of \$200,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University for the Special Services (TRIO) program for improvement of matriculation, retention, and completion rates of minority students at the Edwardsville and Carbondale campuses.

Section 20. The amount of \$1,070,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University for the Presidential Scholarship Fund.

1	Section 25. In addition to any amount previously
2	appropriated, the following named amounts, or so much thereof
3	as may be necessary, are appropriated from the Illinois Jobs
4	Now Fund to the Capital Development Board for Southern
5	Illinois University for the projects hereinafter enumerated:
6	SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY - EDWARDSVILLE
7	For renovating and constructing
8	a Science Laboratory, in addition
9	to funds previously appropriated\$78,867,300
10	SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY - CARBONDALE
11	For constructing a Transportation
12	Education Center, in addition
13	to funds previously appropriated\$56,718,792
14	For planning and beginning a
15	Communications Building\$4,255,400
16	Section 30. The sum of \$17,564,400, or so much thereof as
17	may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Jobs Now
18	Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University
19	for construction and equipment expenses to complete the
20	renovation and expansion of the Morris Library. This
21	appropriation is in addition to funds previously
22	appropriated.

1	Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much
2	thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from the
3	Illinois Jobs Now Fund to the Capital Development Board for
4	Southern Illinois University for miscellaneous capital
5	improvements, including construction, capital facilities,
6	cost of planning, supplies, equipment, materials, services,
7	and all other expenses. These appropriated amounts shall be
8	in addition to any other appropriated amounts which can be
9	expended for such purposes.

14	Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
15	2009.
