SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/9-3-1.5 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Provides that a person commits the offense of concealment of death when he or she knowingly conceals the death of any other person. Provides that a violation is a Class 4 felony.

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
- 5 Section 9-3-1.5 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 9-3-1.5. Concealment of death.</u>
- 8 (a) For purposes of this Section, "conceal" means the
- 9 performing of some act or acts for the purpose of preventing or
- 10 delaying the discovery of a death. "Conceal" means something
- 11 more than simply withholding knowledge or failing to disclose
- 12 information.
- 13 (b) A person commits the offense of concealment of death
- 14 when he or she knowingly conceals the death of any other
- person.
- (c) Sentence. Concealment of death is a Class 4 felony.
