1 AN ACT concerning government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

- **represented in the General Assembly:**
- 4 Section 5. The State Records Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 11 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 160/11) (from Ch. 116, par. 43.14)
- 7 Sec. 11. Violation. All records made or received by or
- 8 under the the authority of or coming into the custody, control
- 9 or possession of public officials of this State in the course
- of their public duties are the property of the State and shall
- 11 not be mutilated, destroyed, transferred, removed or otherwise
- damaged or disposed of, in whole or in part except as provided
- by law. Any person who knowingly and without lawful authority
- 14 alters, destroys, defaces, removes, or conceals any public
- 15 record commits a Class 4 felony.
