2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Marriage and Dissolution of 5 Marriage Act is amended by changing Section 202 as follows:

6 (750 ILCS 5/202) (from Ch. 40, par. 202)

Sec. 202. Marriage License <u>and</u> and Marriage Certificate.)
(a) The Director of Public Health shall prescribe the form
for an application for a marriage license, which shall include
the following information:

(1) name, sex, occupation, address, social security number, date and place of birth of each party to the proposed marriage;

14 (2) if either party was previously married, his name, and 15 the date, place and court in which the marriage was dissolved 16 or declared invalid or the date and place of death of the 17 former spouse;

18 (3) name and address of the parents or guardian of each 19 party; and

20 (4) whether the parties are related to each other and, if21 so, their relationship.

(b) The Director of Public Health shall prescribe the formsfor the marriage license, the marriage certificate and, when
