Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the definition of "offense" for the purpose of inchoate offenses.

- 5 Section 8-6 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/8-6) (from Ch. 38, par. 8-6)
- 7 Sec. 8-6. Offense. For the the purposes of this Article,
- 8 "offense" shall include conduct which if performed in another
- 9 State would be criminal by the laws of that State and which
- 10 conduct if performed in this State would be an offense under
- 11 the laws of this State.
