SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5B-1 305 ILCS 5/5E-5 from Ch. 23, par. 5B-1

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Eliminates facilities licensed under the MR/DD Community Care Act from the definition of "long-term care facility" in the Long-Term Care Provider Funding Article of the Code. Eliminates facilities licensed under the MR/DD Community Care Act from the definition of "nursing home" in the Nursing Home License Fee Article of the Code. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by changing Sections 5B-1 and 5E-5 as follows:

"Hospital provider" means a person licensed by the Department of Public Health to conduct, operate, or maintain a hospital.

"Occupied bed days" shall be computed separately for each long-term care facility operated or maintained by a long-term care provider, and means the sum for all beds of the number of days during the year on which each bed is occupied by a resident (other than a resident receiving care at an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded within the meaning of Title XIX of the Social Security Act).

"Intergovernmental transfer payment" means the payments established under Section 15-3 of this Code, and includes without limitation payments payable under that Section for July, August, and September of 1992.

Sec. 5E-5. Definitions. As used in this Article, unless the context requires otherwise:

"Nursing home" means (i) a skilled nursing or intermediate long-term care facility, whether public or private and whether organized for profit or not-for-profit, that is subject to licensure by the Illinois Department of Public Health under the Nursing Home Care Act or the MR/DD Community Care Act, including a county nursing home directed and maintained under Section 5-1005 of the Counties Code, and (ii) a part of a hospital in which skilled or intermediate long-term care services within the meaning of Title XVIII or XIX of the Social Security Act are provided; except that the term "nursing home" does not include a facility operated solely as an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded within the meaning of Title XIX of the Social Security Act.

"Licensed bed days" shall be computed separately for each nursing home operated or maintained by a nursing home provider and means, with respect to a nursing home provider, the sum for all nursing home beds of the number of days during a calendar quarter on which each bed is covered by a license issued to that provider under the Nursing Home Care Act or the Hospital Licensing Act.
