

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 SB3584

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 505/2III new

Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Provides that it is an unlawful practice for a tower to misrepresent an affiliation with the State, a unit of local government, an insurance company, a private club, or any other entity for the purpose of securing a business transaction with a vehicle owner or operator.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
- 5 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2III as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2III new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2III. Towers; misrepresentation of affiliation.</u>
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "tower" has the meaning
- 9 ascribed to it in Section 1-205.2 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
- 10 (b) It shall be unlawful for any tower to misrepresent an
- 11 affiliation with the State, a unit of local government, an
- insurance company, a private club, or any other entity for the
- purpose of securing a business transaction with a vehicle owner
- or operator.
