1 AN ACT concerning corrections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 7 Sec. 5.777. The State Police Streetgang-Related Crime
- 8 Fund.

- 10 <u>Sec. 8p. State Police Streetgang-Related Crime Fund.</u>
- 11 (a) The State Police Streetgang-Related Crime Fund is
- 12 created as a special fund in the State treasury.
- 13 (b) All moneys collected and payable to the Department of
- 14 <u>State Police under Section 5-9-1.19 of the Unified Code of</u>
- 15 Corrections shall be deposited into the State Police
- 16 Streetgang-Related Crime Fund and shall be appropriated to and
- 17 administered by the Department of State Police for operations
- 18 and initiatives to combat and prevent streetgang-related
- 19 crime.
- Section 10. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by
- 21 adding Section 5-9-1.19 as follows:

Sec. 5-9-1.19. Additional streetgang fine. In addition to 2 3 any other penalty imposed, a fine of \$100 shall be imposed upon 4 a person convicted of any violation of the Criminal Code of 5 1961 who was, at the time of the commission of the violation a 6 streetgang member, as defined in Section 10 of the Illinois Streetgang Terrorism Omnibus Prevention Act. Such additional 7 8 fine shall be assessed by the court imposing sentence and shall 9 be collected by the circuit clerk. Of this fee, \$5 shall be 10 deposited into the Circuit Court Clerk Operation and 11 Administrative Fund created by the Clerk of the Circuit Court 12 to be used to offset the costs incurred by the Circuit Court 13 Clerk in performing the additional duties required to collect and disburse funds as provided by law. Each such additional 14 15 fine shall be remitted by the Circuit Court Clerk within one 16 month after receipt to the State Police Streetgang-Related Crime Fund in the State treasury. 17

18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 19 becoming law.
