1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

22

WHEREAS, During the 1970s, a special provision was written 2 3 into the Social Security Act of 1935 concerning contingent 4 academic workers; that provision excluded education workers 5 of unemployment benefits receipt unless 6 demonstrate that they do not have "reasonable assurance" of 7 continued employment; and 8 WHEREAS, Academic contingent workers in higher education 9 are frequently denied access to unemployment benefits based on 10 a very broad interpretation of "reasonable assurance"; therefore, be it 11 12 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL 13 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 14 CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the Unemployment Insurance for Contingent Academic Workers Task Force; and be it 15 16 further RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall be charged with the 17 18 following tasks: 19 (1) to estimate costs to higher education institutions of a change in law that allows contingent academics to 20 21 collect unemployment insurance; and

(2) to examine the growth of employment of part-time

- 1 contingent faculty over the past 10 years; and be it 2 further
- RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall be composed of the following:
 - (1) 2 members who are statewide education labor union representatives from a 2-year institution; each member shall be appointed by the union that he or she represents;
 - (2) 2 members who are statewide education labor union representatives from a 4-year institution; each member shall be appointed by the union that he or she represents;
 - (3) 2 members who are management representatives from higher education institutions appointed by the Board of Higher Education;
 - (4) one member appointed by the Director of Employment Security;
 - (5) 4 legislative members; one of whom shall be appointed by the President of the Senate; one of whom shall be appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate; one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and one of whom shall be appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; and
 - (6) one member appointed by the Governor; and be it further
 - RESOLVED, That the Task Force may hold hearings on the

- 1 issue of unemployment insurance for contingent academic
- 2 workers and shall report its findings to the General Assembly
- 3 on or before July 1, 2010; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
- 5 delivered to the Board of Higher Education, the Director of
- 6 Employment Security, and the Governor.
