1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 29

WHEREAS, During the 1970s, a special provision was written
into the Social Security Act of 1935 concerning contingent
academic workers; that provision excluded education workers
from receipt of unemployment benefits unless they can
demonstrate that they do not have "reasonable assurance" of
continued employment; and

- WHEREAS, Academic contingent workers in higher education are frequently denied access to unemployment benefits based on a very broad interpretation of "reasonable assurance"; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL

  ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

  CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the Unemployment

  Insurance for Contingent Academic Workers Task Force; and be it

  further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall be charged with the 18 following tasks:
- 19 (1) to estimate costs to higher education institutions 20 of a change in law that allows contingent academics to 21 collect unemployment insurance; and
- 22 (2) to examine the growth of employment of part-time

- (1) 2 members who are statewide education labor union representatives from a 2-year institution; each member shall be appointed by the union that he or she represents;
- (2) 2 members who are statewide education labor union representatives from a 4-year institution; each member shall be appointed by the union that he or she represents;
- (3) 4 members who are management representatives from higher education institutions appointed by the Board of Higher Education;
- (4) one member appointed by the Director of Employment Security;
- (5) 4 legislative members; one of whom shall be appointed by the President of the Senate; one of whom shall be appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate; one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and one of whom shall be appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; and
- (6) one member appointed by the Governor; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force may hold hearings on the

- on or before July 1, 2010; and be it further
