10 Cook with respect to the limitation of administrative costs,
11 identified in the report filed by the State Board of Education
12 as request WM100-4945, is disapproved; and be it further

15 number and subject area of the waiver request as summarized in
16 the report filed by the State Board of Education is approved
17 for only one year and disapproved for the remaining years:

2 education - behind-the-wheel instruction; and be it

5 with respect to driver education - fee limits, identified in

7 WM100-5014, is approved for \$350 and disapproved for any
