1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 114

2 WHEREAS, The State Board of Education has filed its Report 3 on Waiver of School Code Mandates, dated March 1, 2010, with 4 the Senate, the House of Representatives, and the Secretary of 5 State of Illinois as required by Section 2-3.25g of the School 6 Code; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that the appeal of an administrative rule waiver request made by Elgin SD 46 - Kane with respect to transitional bilingual education that was denied by the State Board of Education, identified in the report filed by the State Board of Education as request WM200-5289-3A, is denied; and be it further

RESOLVED, That each of the school district waiver requests identified below by school district name and by the identifying number and subject area of the waiver request as summarized in the report filed by the State Board of Education is approved for only one year and disapproved for the remaining years:
