1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 114

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Joint Resolution 114 by
3 replacing lines 7 through 12 with the following:

4 "RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL
5 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
6 CONCURRING HEREIN, that the appeal of an administrative rule
7 waiver request made by Elgin SD 46 - Kane with respect to
8 transitional bilingual education that was denied by the State
9 Board of Education, identified in the report filed by the State
10 Board of Education as request WM200-5289-3A, is denied; and be
11 it further

12 RESOLVED, That each of the school district waiver requests
13 identified below by school district name and by the identifying
14 number and subject area of the waiver request as summarized in
15 the report filed by the State Board of Education is approved
16 for only one year and disapproved for the remaining years:

10 - behind-the-wheel instruction;

11 (6) Triad CUSD 2 - Madison, WM100-5305, driver
12 education - behind-the-wheel instruction; and

13 (7) Thornton Fractional THSD 215 - Cook, WM100-5320-1,
14 driver education - behind-the-wheel instruction; and be it
15 further

16 RESOLVED, That the request made by Elgin SD U-46 - Kane
17 with respect to driver education - behind-the-wheel
18 instruction, identified in the report filed by the State Board
19 of Education as request WM100-5289-2, is approved for only one
20 year and for the substitution of only 4 hours of
21 behind-the-wheel instruction with 16 hours of simulator use and
22 is disapproved for the remaining years and hour; and be it
23 further;

24 RESOLVED, That the request made by Palatine CCSD 15 - Cook

1 with respect to physical education, identified in the report
2 filed by the State Board of Education as request WM100-5294, is
3 approved; however, this approval shall not be interpreted as
4 General Assembly approval of the merits of the district's
5 non-uniform recess policy."
