## SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Merl Eugene Clark of Indianola, who 4 passed away on January 16, 2009; and

5 WHEREAS, Merl Eugene Clark was born the son of John William 6 and Clara Rena Margaret Bialeschki Clark on July 9, 1922 at 7 Rose Hill; he married Frances Juanita Smith on October 5, 1946 8 in Pulaski, Virginia; and

9 WHEREAS, He had a 20-year career in the United States Navy 10 and was a World War II Veteran, where he received 13 battle star citations and 5 personal citations from the Navy; 6 of 11 those 20 years were served on the U.S.S. Boise CL47; he 12 13 participated in the Battle of Cape Esperance (sunk 4 ships), 14 the Battle of Guadalcanal, The Lone Tokyo Raid, and the Battle of Leyte Gulf; and he was aboard the U.S.S. Boise during the 15 Lingayen Gulf Landing (Philippines) with General Douglas 16 17 MacArthur; he was also the commanding officer of approximately eight different LCU, a recruiter, deep sea diver, and an 18 19 instructor; and
