2	WHEREAS,	The members	of the	Illinois	Senate	are	saddened	to
3	learn of th	e death of	Jurisdi	ctional	Bishop	W.L.	Porter	of
4	Memphis, Ten	nessee, who j	passed a	away on Aj	pril 11,	2009	9; and	

- 5 WHEREAS, Bishop Porter is the founder of the Greater 6 Community Temple Church of God in Christ (COGIC) in Memphis, 7 which he began 37 years ago; in 1981, he organized the Central 8 Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of Tennessee Jurisdiction Church 9 Of God In Christ; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Central has grown to be the largest COGIC
 11 Jurisdiction in the state of Tennessee; the geographic reach of
 12 churches in this fellowship spans from Memphis to Chattanooga
 13 with Jurisdictional Headquarters located in Jackson,
 14 Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Bishop W. L. Porter had been a tremendous force throughout COGIC and had served in several capacities; he worked very closely with Bishop C. H. Mason, Founder of the Church Of God In Christ, and other national leaders; he brought meaningful structure to the organization and significant innovation to COGIC operations over the past fifty years; and he coordinated COGIC's largest convention, The Holy Convocation for over 30 years; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Bishop Porter was responsible for transitioning
- 2 The Holy Convention from Mason Temple to the Mid-South
- 3 Coliseum, then to The Cook Convention Center and The Pyramid in
- 4 Memphis; he also served as Director of COGIC Housing for over
- 5 30 years; and he created and organized COGIC Courtesy Cars; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Presiding Bishop Charles E. Blake and The General
- 7 Board announced that Superintendent Brandon B. Porter will
- 8 succeed his father as Jurisdictional Bishop of Central
- 9 Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of Tennessee at an installation
- 10 service to be held during the Holy Convocation of the Church Of
- 11 God In Christ in November of 2009; therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL
- 13 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we mourn, along with
- 14 his family, friends, and church family, the passing of Bishop
- W. L. Porter; and be it further
