WHEREAS, Dr. Julius Newman attended the University of Illinois and attended his medical residency at Edward Hines, Jr. VA Hospital; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Julius Newman practiced internal medicine in Aurora until he transitioned into an administrative position at Copley Hospital; as VP of Medical Affairs and Continuing Medical Education (CME), he was instrumental in expanding the Copley community through cultivation of medical personnel and the building of the new Rush-Copley Medical Center; during his period of semi-retirement until January 2009, he continued his role of managing the CME program and his life-long commitment
