1 SENATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, A recent analysis shows that more than half of all 2 3 Illinois children suspended from public schools 4 African-American, even though thev represent less t.han 5 one-fifth of the enrollment; and 6 WHEREAS, Expulsions rates also disproportionally hit 7 African-American students, causing them to miss more classroom 8 instruction time, which leads to increased rates of drop outs, 9 joblessness, and incarceration; and 10 last decade, WHEREAS, In the suspensions of African-American students have escalated by 75% while those of 11 12 white students have dropped more than 5%; white students are 13 expelled 16% more often than they were 10 years ago, but 14 African-American students are expelled 56% more often; and WHEREAS, Caucasian students make up nearly three-fifths of 1.5 public school enrollment, yet in the most recent data, they 16 account for one-third or fewer of both suspensions and 17 18 expulsions; therefore, be it 19 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that the Task Force on 20 21 Eliminating Racial Bias in Suspensions and Expulsions be

convened, consisting of eleven members as follows: 1 2 (1) one member appointed by the Governor, who shall 3 serve as chair; (2) one member appointed by the President of the Senate: (3) one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of 6 7 Representatives; 8 (4) one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the 9 Senate: 10 (5) one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the 11 House of Representatives; (6) one member appointed by the Chairperson of the 12 13 Illinois State Board of Education; (7) one member appointed by the Governor upon the 14 recommendation of an 15 association representing school 16 boards; 17 (8) one member appointed by the Governor upon the recommendation of the Chicago Board of Education; 18 (9) one member appointed by the Governor upon the 19 20 recommendation of an organization representing teachers; 21 (10) one member appointed by the Governor upon the 22 recommendation of a different organization representing 23 teachers: and

(11) one member appointed by the Governor upon the

recommendation of an association representing regional

superintendents, who shall have expertise in administering

1 a regional safe school program; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall examine the causes of the racial gap in suspension and expulsion rates, consider the long-term implications of the inequity, and issue a report to the General Assembly by April 15, 2010 that makes recommendations for removing bias from the suspension and expulsion processes.
