2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Robert Lawrence Yancey of Godfrey, who 4 passed away on March 16, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, He was born on March 3, 1925, in Alton, to Walter 6 Scott and Mabel (Dougherty) Yancey; his parents died when he 7 was young, and he was raised by Charlie and Alpha Yancey; he 8 married Earlene Waggoner on June 25, 1949, in Brighton; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Yancey was a graduate of Brighton High School 10 and Shurtleff College, where he received a degree in business 11 administration; and

WHEREAS, He was unable to enlist in the military during World War II due to deafness in one ear, so he served as a battlefield medic with the 19th Indian Division of the British Fourteenth Army through the auspices of the American Field Service; he participated in engagements in India and Burma in 1943 and 1944 and was wounded at the Battle of Kohima in June of 1944; and

WHEREAS, After his return from the war, he worked at Warner Funeral Home and the Illinois Glass Company until he was drafted into the United States Navy; after his honorable

- 3 where he retired in 1993; and

- 7 he loved to travel and he loved dogs; he will be remembered for
