WHEREAS, Louis Alegnani was a retired loan supervisor for Finance America, a division of the Bank of America; he was also employed as a loan supervisor for GAC Finance and the White Loan Company in Herrin; and

WHEREAS, Louis Alegnani was a member of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church in Herrin; he was a member of the Knights of Columbus Council 2164, having served as the council's Grand Knight; he was a former Exalted Ruler of Herrin Elks Lodge 1146 and a past president of the Herrin Rotary Club;
