WHEREAS, She will be remembered for her selflessness, 15 independence, and genuine frankness all enhanced by wit and 16 sense of humor; these qualities came through in golf and 17 18 tennis, expertise at card games and rummikub, adeptness at 19 hosting parties, and the chocolate chip cookies that delighted three generations of her offspring; she was a founding member 20 21 of the St. Joseph Junior Hospital League, Nouveau Speculators, 22 and the Elgin Golferettes; and
