8 WHEREAS, He served the community for 35 years with local 9 delivery of petroleum and served as Montgomery County Clerk for 10 16 years; he retired in late 1998; he graduated from Hillsboro 11 High School, class of 1941; and

12 WHEREAS, He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in 13 Hillsboro, Mt. Moriah Masonic Lodge #51 AF & AM in Hillsboro, 14 V.F.W. Post #1306 in Taylor Springs, and Hillsboro Moose Lodge 15 #1377; he was a veteran of World War II with the Army Air Corp 16 from 1943 to 1945; he was a B17 gunner who served in Normandy, 17 Northern France Ardennes, Rhineland; he earned 4 Bronze Stars, 18 a Good Conduct Air Medal, 3 Bronze Clusters, and 1 0/s Bar; and

WHEREAS, He married Vivian M. Havron on July 14, 1946 at the Presbyterian parsonage in Hillsboro; she preceded him in death on October 7, 1990; his son, Robert L.
