2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Peter M. Rosenthal, who passed away on 4 November 8, 2010; and

5 WHEREAS, He was born in Chicago; he graduated from the 6 University of Chicago Lab School; he received his Bachelor's 7 degree from the University of Pennsylvania in 1971 and his law 8 degree from the University of Michigan; and

9 WHEREAS, He joined the Ancel Glink law firm in Chicago, 10 which specializes in municipal law; while working for the firm, 11 he began representing local governments, including Rosemont 12 and Fox River Grove; Mr. Rosenthal worked closely with Donald 13 E. Stephens, Rosemont's mayor from 1956 to 2007; he was 14 Rosemont's attorney during the long, unsuccessful fight to 15 obtain a casino; and

16 WHEREAS, In 1987, Mr. Rosenthal and several colleagues 17 formed their own firm: Rosenthal, Murphey, Coblentz & Donahue; 18 and
