10 WHEREAS, She was born and raised in the Chicago area, and 11 later attended the University of Wisconsin, Madison as her 12 father had before her; she was a member of the Alpha Gamma 13 Delta sorority and graduated with a degree in journalism; and

14 WHEREAS, She was an accomplished journalist and managing 15 editor of 2 national publications, "Small Homes Guide" and 16 "Home Modernizing"; she also worked as a freelance travel and 17 feature writer for the Chicago Tribune for many years; one of 18 her proudest accomplishments was to have one of her travel 19 stories on France on the cover of the travel section of the 20 Chicago Tribune; and
