

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is  
5 amended by changing Section 13.1 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 65/13.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1)

7 Sec. 13.1. (a) The regulation of the ownership and  
8 possession of firearms and ammunition, components,  
9 accessories, or accoutrements for firearms are exclusive  
10 powers and functions of the State. A unit of local government,  
11 including a home rule unit, may not require the registration of  
12 the person or firearm or ammunition as a condition of ownership  
13 or possession.

14 (b) The provisions of any ordinance or resolution after the  
15 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 97th General  
16 Assembly by any unit of local government that imposes  
17 restrictions or limitations on the ownership or possession of  
18 firearms and ammunition, components, accessories, and  
19 accoutrements of firearms in a manner other than the  
20 requirements that are imposed by this Act or Article 24 of the  
21 Criminal Code of 1961 are invalid and all those existing  
22 ordinances and resolutions are void.

23 (c) This Section is a limitation of home rule powers under

1 subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois  
2 Constitution.

3 ~~The provisions of any ordinance enacted by any municipality~~  
4 ~~which requires registration or imposes greater restrictions or~~  
5 ~~limitations on the acquisition, possession and transfer of~~  
6 ~~firearms than are imposed by this Act, are not invalidated or~~  
7 ~~affected by this Act.~~
