1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 176

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 176 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Sections 5.786 and 8q as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/5.786 new)

7 Sec. 5.786. The Illinois Department of Corrections Parole
8 Division Offender Supervision Fund.

9 (30 ILCS 105/8q new)

10 Sec. 8q. Illinois Department of Corrections Parole
11 Division Offender Supervision Fund.

12 (a) The Illinois Department of Corrections Parole Division
13 Offender Supervision Fund is created as a special fund in the
14 State treasury.

15 (b) All moneys collected and payable to the Department of

1 Corrections under Section 5-9-1.20 of the Unified Code of
2 Corrections shall be deposited into the Illinois Department of
3 Corrections Parole Division Offender Supervision Fund and
4 shall be appropriated to and administered by the Department of
5 Corrections for operations and initiatives to combat and
6 supervise paroled offenders in the community.

7 (c) The Illinois Department of Corrections Parole Division
8 Offender Supervision Fund shall not be subject to
9 administrative chargebacks.

10 Section 10. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by
11 adding Section 5-9-1.20 as follows:

12 (730 ILCS 5/5-9-1.20 new)

13 Sec. 5-9-1.20. Additional violation of parole fines. In
14 addition to any other penalty imposed, a fine of \$25 shall be
15 imposed upon a person convicted of any violation of the
16 Criminal Code of 1961 who was, at the time of the commission of
17 the offense on parole or mandatory supervised release. Such
18 additional fine shall be assessed by the court imposing
19 sentence and shall be collected by the circuit clerk. Of this
20 fine, \$5 shall be deposited into the Circuit Court Clerk
21 Operation and Administrative Fund created by the Clerk of the
22 Circuit Court to be used to offset the costs incurred by the
23 Circuit Court Clerk in performing the additional duties
24 required to collect and disburse funds as provided by law. The

1 remainder of each such additional fine shall be remitted by the
2 Circuit Court Clerk within one month after receipt to the State
3 Treasurer for deposit into the Illinois Department of
4 Corrections Parole Division Offender Supervision Fund in the
5 State treasury.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
7 becoming law.".
