2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 176 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5	Sections 5.786 and 8q as follows:
6	(30 ILCS 105/5.786 new)
7	Sec. 5.786. The Illinois Department of Corrections Parole
8	Division Offender Supervision Fund.
9	(30 ILCS 105/8q new)
10	Sec. 8q. Illinois Department of Corrections Parole
11	Division Offender Supervision Fund.
12	(a) The Illinois Department of Corrections Parole Division
13	Offender Supervision Fund is created as a special fund in the
14	State treasury.
15	(b) All moneys collected and payable to the Department of

- 1 Corrections under Section 5-9-1.20 of the Unified Code of
- 2 Corrections shall be deposited into the Illinois Department of
- 3 Corrections Parole Division Offender Supervision Fund and
- 4 shall be appropriated to and administered by the Department of
- 5 Corrections for operations and initiatives to combat and
- 6 supervise paroled offenders in the community.
- 7 (c) The Illinois Department of Corrections Parole Division
- 8 Offender Supervision Fund shall not be subject to
- 9 <u>administrative chargebacks</u>.
- 10 Section 10. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by
- 11 adding Section 5-9-1.20 as follows:
- 12 (730 ILCS 5/5-9-1.20 new)
- 13 <u>Sec. 5-9-1.20. Additional violation of parole fines. In</u>
- 14 addition to any other penalty imposed, a fine of \$25 shall be
- 15 <u>imposed upon a person convicted of any violation of the</u>
- 16 Criminal Code of 1961 who was, at the time of the commission of
- 17 the offense on parole or mandatory supervised release. Such
- 18 additional fine shall be assessed by the court imposing
- 19 sentence and shall be collected by the circuit clerk. Of this
- 20 fine, \$5 shall be deposited into the Circuit Court Clerk
- Operation and Administrative Fund created by the Clerk of the
- 22 <u>Circuit Court to be used to offset the costs incurred by the</u>
- 23 Circuit Court Clerk in performing the additional duties
- 24 required to collect and disburse funds as provided by law. The

- remainder of each such additional fine shall be remitted by the 1
- 2 Circuit Court Clerk within one month after receipt to the State
- Treasurer for deposit into the Illinois Department of 3
- 4 <u>Corrections Parole Division Offender Supervision Fund in the</u>
- 5 State treasury.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 6
- 7 becoming law.".
