1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 200

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 200 as follows:

3 by replacing line 14 on page 2 through line 7 on page 3 with the
4 following:

5 "(b) Each school board shall adopt a policy regarding
6 student athlete concussions and head injuries that is in
7 compliance with the protocols, policies, and by-laws of the
8 Illinois High School Association. Information on the school
9 board's concussion and head injury policy must be a part of any
10 agreement, contract, code, or other written instrument that a
11 school district requires a student athlete and his or her
12 parents or guardian to sign before participating in practice or
13 interscholastic competition.

14 (c) The Illinois High School Association shall make
15 available to all school districts, including elementary school
16 districts, education materials, such as visual presentations
17 and other written materials, that describe the nature and risk

1 of concussions and head injuries. Each school district shall
2 use education materials provided by the Illinois High School
3 Association to educate coaches, student athletes, and parents
4 and guardians of student athletes about the nature and risk of
5 concussions and head injuries, including continuing play after
6 a concussion or head injury."; and

7 by replacing line 14 on page 4 through line 6 on page 5 with the
8 following:

9 "(b) The board shall adopt a policy regarding student
10 athlete concussions and head injuries that is in compliance
11 with the protocols, policies, and by-laws of the Illinois High
12 School Association. Information on the board's concussion and
13 head injury policy must be a part of any agreement, contract,
14 code, or other written instrument that the school district
15 requires a student athlete and his or her parents or guardian
16 to sign before participating in practice or interscholastic
17 competition.

18 (c) The Illinois High School Association shall make
19 available to the school district education materials, such as
20 visual presentations and other written materials, that
21 describe the nature and risk of concussions and head injuries.
22 The school district shall use education materials provided by
23 the Illinois High School Association to educate coaches,
24 student athletes, and parents and guardians of student athletes
25 about the nature and risk of concussions and head injuries,

1 including continuing play after a concussion or head injury.".
