

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much of those  
6 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes named, are appropriated to the Illinois State  
8 Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
9 2011:

4 Section 20. The amount of \$592,300, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
6 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
7 associated with the Community Residential Services Authority.

8 Section 25. The amount of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Temporary  
10 Relocation Expenses Revolving Grant Fund for use by the State  
11 Board of Education as provided in Section 2-3.77 of the  
12 School Code.

13 Section 30. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof  
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
16 associated with implementation of the State Board of  
17 Education Strategic Plan.

18 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much  
19 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
20 State Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July  
21 1, 2011:

1 From the General Revenue Fund:

2 For Bilingual Education .....63,381,200

3 Section 40. The amount of \$24,000,000, or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
5 Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for  
6 Student Assessments, including Bilingual Assessments.

7 Section 45. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
9 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
10 associated with Standards, Materials, and Training for  
11 Teachers

12 Section 50. The amount of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
14 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
15 associated with After School Matters.

16 Section 55. The amount of \$1, or so much thereof as may  
17 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
18 to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
19 associated with the Response to Intervention Initiative.

20 Section 60. The amount of \$184,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 2 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for all costs  
 3 associated with Educator Misconduct Investigations.

4 Section 65. The amount of \$9,100,000, or so much thereof  
 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School  
 6 Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education for Regional  
 7 Superintendents' and Assistants' Compensation.

8 Section 70. The following named amounts, or so much  
 9 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
 10 State Board of Education for the fiscal year beginning July  
 11 1, 2011:

12 From the General Revenue Fund:

13 For Regional Superintendents' Services .....2,225,050  
 14 For Regional Superintendents' Services -  
 15 Bus Driver Training .....70,000

16 ARTICLE 2

17 Section 5. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
 19 Fund to the Illinois Community College Board for costs  
 20 associated with the Re-Enrollment Student Program.
