1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 700

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 700 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Administrative Procedure Act is
5 amended by changing Section 10-65 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 100/10-65) (from Ch. 127, par. 1010-65)

7 Sec. 10-65. Licenses.

8 (a) When any licensing is required by law to be preceded by
9 notice and an opportunity for a hearing, the provisions of this
10 Act concerning contested cases shall apply.

11 (b) When a licensee has made timely and sufficient
12 application for the renewal of a license or a new license with
13 reference to any activity of a continuing nature, the existing
14 license shall continue in full force and effect until the final
15 agency decision on the application has been made unless a later
16 date is fixed by order of a reviewing court.

1 (c) An application for ~~Except as provided in Section 1-17~~
2 ~~of the Department of Natural Resources Act, an application for~~
3 ~~the renewal of a license or~~ a new license shall include the
4 applicant's social security number. As soon as practicable, an
5 agency must assign a customer identification number to each
6 applicant for a license that the applicant may use in place of
7 his or her social security number on any subsequent application
8 for a license or renewal of a license. A licensee's social
9 security number shall not appear on the face of his or her
10 license. Each agency shall require the licensee to certify on
11 the application form, under penalty of perjury, that he or she
12 is not more than 30 days delinquent in complying with a child
13 support order. Every application shall state that failure to so
14 certify shall result in disciplinary action, and that making a
15 false statement may subject the licensee to contempt of court.
16 The agency shall notify each applicant or licensee who
17 acknowledges a delinquency or who, contrary to his or her
18 certification, is found to be delinquent or who after receiving
19 notice, fails to comply with a subpoena or warrant relating to
20 a paternity or a child support proceeding, that the agency
21 intends to take disciplinary action. Accordingly, the agency
22 shall provide written notice of the facts or conduct upon which
23 the agency will rely to support its proposed action and the
24 applicant or licensee shall be given an opportunity for a
25 hearing in accordance with the provisions of the Act concerning
26 contested cases. Any delinquency in complying with a child

1 support order can be remedied by arranging for payment of past
2 due and current support. Any failure to comply with a subpoena
3 or warrant relating to a paternity or child support proceeding
4 can be remedied by complying with the subpoena or warrant. Upon
5 a final finding of delinquency or failure to comply with a
6 subpoena or warrant, the agency shall suspend, revoke, or
7 refuse to issue or renew the license. In cases in which the
8 Department of Healthcare and Family Services (formerly
9 Department of Public Aid) has previously determined that an
10 applicant or a licensee is more than 30 days delinquent in the
11 payment of child support and has subsequently certified the
12 delinquency to the licensing agency, and in cases in which a
13 court has previously determined that an applicant or licensee
14 has been in violation of the Non-Support Punishment Act for
15 more than 60 days, the licensing agency shall refuse to issue
16 or renew or shall revoke or suspend that person's license based
17 solely upon the certification of delinquency made by the
18 Department of Healthcare and Family Services (formerly
19 Department of Public Aid) or the certification of violation
20 made by the court. Further process, hearings, or
21 redetermination of the delinquency or violation by the
22 licensing agency shall not be required. The licensing agency
23 may issue or renew a license if the licensee has arranged for
24 payment of past and current child support obligations in a
25 manner satisfactory to the Department of Healthcare and Family
26 Services (formerly Department of Public Aid) or the court. The

1 licensing agency may impose conditions, restrictions, or
2 disciplinary action upon that license.

3 (d) Except as provided in subsection (c), no agency shall
4 revoke, suspend, annul, withdraw, amend materially, or refuse
5 to renew any valid license without first giving written notice
6 to the licensee of the facts or conduct upon which the agency
7 will rely to support its proposed action and an opportunity for
8 a hearing in accordance with the provisions of this Act
9 concerning contested cases. At the hearing, the licensee shall
10 have the right to show compliance with all lawful requirements
11 for the retention, continuation, or renewal of the license. If,
12 however, the agency finds that the public interest, safety, or
13 welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and if the
14 agency incorporates a finding to that effect in its order,
15 summary suspension of a license may be ordered pending
16 proceedings for revocation or other action. Those proceedings
17 shall be promptly instituted and determined.

18 (e) Any application for renewal of a license that contains
19 required and relevant information, data, material, or
20 circumstances that were not contained in an application for the
21 existing license shall be subject to the provisions of
22 subsection (a).
