

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Department of State Police Law of the Civil
5 Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section
6 2605-90 as follows:

10 Sec. 2605-90. Training; death and homicide investigations.
11 The Department shall provide training in death and homicide
12 investigation for State police officers. Only State police
13 officers who successfully complete the training may be assigned
14 as lead investigators in death and homicide investigations.
15 Satisfactory completion of the training shall be evidenced by a
16 certificate issued to the officer by the Department.

17 The Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board
18 shall develop a process for waiver applications sent by the
19 agency administrator for those officers whose prior training
20 and experience as homicide investigators may qualify them for a
21 waiver. The Board may issue a waiver at its discretion, based
22 solely on the prior training and experience of an officer as a
23 homicide investigator.

2 Section 10. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by
3 changing Section 10.11 as follows:

4 (50 ILCS 705/10.11)

7 Sec. 10.11. Training; death and homicide investigation.
8 The Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board shall
9 conduct or approve a training program in death and homicide
10 investigation for the training of law enforcement officers of
11 local government agencies. Only law enforcement officers who
12 successfully complete the training program may be assigned as
13 lead investigators in death and homicide investigations.
14 Satisfactory completion of the training program shall be
15 evidenced by a certificate issued to the law enforcement
16 officer by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards
17 Board.

18 The Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board
19 shall develop a process for waiver applications sent by the
20 agency administrator for those officers whose prior training
21 and experience as homicide investigators may qualify them for a
22 waiver. The Board may issue a waiver at its discretion, based
23 solely on the prior training and experience of an officer as a
24 homicide investigator.
