### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 320/42

Amends the Illinois Plumbing License Law. Changes the home rule provision to provide that the power to regulate the licensing of plumbers, to adopt a minimum plumbing code of standards, and the regulation of the registration of irrigation contractors and plumbing contractors, except as otherwise provided within and under the provisions of this Act, shall be exercised by the State and may not be exercised by any unit of local government, including home rule units. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Plumbing License Law is amended by
changing Section 42 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 320/42)

7 Sec. 42. Home rule. Pursuant to paragraph (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 the power 8 9 regulate the licensing of plumbers, to to adopt the promulgation of a minimum plumbing code of standards, and the 10 power to regulate the registration of irrigation contractors 11 and plumbing contractors shall, except as may otherwise be 12 provided within and pursuant to the provisions of Section 16 13 14 and Section 16.1 of this Act, be exercised by the State and may not be exercised by any unit of local government, including 15 16 home rule units.
