1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1377

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1377 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding  
5 Sections 11-214 and 11-215 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-214 new)

7 Sec. 11-214. Local government reporting.

8 (a) Local units of government shall report to the Illinois  
9 Department of Transportation and the Department shall post on  
10 its official website (i) all preferred truck routes under the  
11 local unit of government's jurisdiction which are not  
12 classified as Class II or Class III truck routes; and (ii) the  
13 unit of local government's designated truck route network.

14 (b) If a local unit of government has no designated truck  
15 routes or preferred truck routes described by subsection (a)  
16 above, the local unit of government shall affirm to the

1 Department that it has no such truck routes.

2 (625 ILCS 5/11-215 new)

3 Sec. 11-215. Secretary of State to provide information on  
4 use of truck global positioning systems.

5 (a) The Secretary of State shall include in its commercial  
6 drivers license curriculum and study guide the distinctions  
7 between utilizing a truck-attributed global positioning system  
8 device and other non-truck-attributed global positioning  
9 system devices.

10 (b) The Secretary of State shall develop a brochure  
11 regarding the distinctions between utilizing a  
12 truck-attributed global positioning system device and other  
13 non-truck-attributed global positioning system devices and  
14 shall make this brochure available at all Secretary of State  
15 facilities where an applicant may obtain or renew a commercial  
16 drivers license.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January  
18 1, 2012."
