2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1521, on page 2, by
3 replacing lines 2 through 6 with the following:

4 "(b) For facilities licensed under this Act, the Office of
5 the State Fire Marshal shall provide the necessary fire
6 inspection to comply with licensing requirements. The Office of
7 the State Fire Marshal may enter into an agreement with another
8 State agency to conduct this inspection if qualified personnel
9 are employed by that agency. Code enforcement inspection of the
10 facility by the local authority shall only occur if the local
11 authority having jurisdiction enforces code requirements that
12 are more stringent than those enforced by the State Fire
13 Marshal. Nothing in this Section shall prohibit a local fire
14 authority from conducting fire incident planning activities.";

16 on page 3, by replacing lines 4 through 8 with the following:

17 "(b) For facilities licensed under this Act, the Office of

1 the State Fire Marshal shall provide the necessary fire
2 inspection to comply with licensing requirements. The Office of
3 the State Fire Marshal may enter into an agreement with another
4 State agency to conduct this inspection if qualified personnel
5 are employed by that agency. Code enforcement inspection of the
6 facility by the local authority shall only occur if the local
7 authority having jurisdiction enforces code requirements that
8 are more stringent than those enforced by the State Fire
9 Marshal. Nothing in this Section shall prohibit a local fire
10 authority from conducting fire incident planning activities.";

14 under this Act, the Office of the State Fire Marshal shall
15 provide the necessary fire inspection to comply with licensing
16 requirements. The Office of the State Fire Marshal may enter
17 into an agreement with another State agency to conduct this
18 inspection if qualified personnel are employed by that agency.
19 Code enforcement inspection of the facility by the local
20 authority shall only occur if the local authority having
21 jurisdiction enforces code requirements that are more
22 stringent than those enforced by the State Fire Marshal.
23 Nothing in this Section shall prohibit a local fire authority
24 from conducting fire incident planning activities."; and

1 on page 5, by replacing lines 10 through 15 with the following:

2 "(b) For child care facilities licensed under this Act, the
3 Office of the State Fire Marshal shall provide the necessary
4 fire inspection to comply with licensing requirements. The
5 Office of the State Fire Marshal may enter into an agreement
6 with another State agency to conduct this inspection if
7 qualified personnel are employed by that agency. Code
8 enforcement inspection of the facility by the local authority
9 shall only occur if the local authority having jurisdiction
10 enforces code requirements that are more stringent than those
11 enforced by the State Fire Marshal. Nothing in this Section
12 shall prohibit a local fire authority from conducting fire
13 incident planning activities."; and

14 on page 6, by replacing lines 13 through 18 with the following:

15 "(b) For provider organizations established under this
16 Act, the Office of the State Fire Marshal shall provide the
17 necessary fire inspection to comply with this Act. The Office
18 of the State Fire Marshal may enter into an agreement with
19 another State agency to conduct this inspection if qualified
20 personnel are employed by that agency. Code enforcement
21 inspection of the facility by the local authority shall only
22 occur if the local authority having jurisdiction enforces code
23 requirements that are more stringent than those enforced by the
24 State Fire Marshal. Nothing in this Section shall prohibit a
25 local fire authority from conducting fire incident planning
