16 Illinois Alcoholism and Other Drug Abuse and Dependency Act";

18 on page 12, line 9, by replacing "or" with "~~or~~"; and

19 on page 12, line 10, by replacing "therapist" with "therapist,

9 Illinois Alcoholism and Other Drug Abuse and Dependency Act";
10 and

11 on page 12, line 20, immediately after "renewed", by inserting
12 "on or"; and

13 on page 12, line 22, by replacing "consistent" with "and
14 substance use disorders consistent"; and

15 on page 13, line 25, by replacing "~~and~~" with "and"; and

16 on page 13, line 26, by replacing "nervosa; ~~and~~." with
17 "nervosa."; and

18 on page 14, by replacing lines 1 through 3 with the following:

19 "(2.5) "Substance use disorder" means the following mental

1 disorders as defined in the most current edition of the
2 Diagnostic and Statistical Manual (DSM) published by the
3 American Psychiatric Association:

4 (A) substance abuse disorders;

5 (B) substance dependence disorders; and

6 (C) substance induced disorders.

7 (3) Unless otherwise prohibited by federal law and
8 consistent with the parity requirements of Section"; and

9 on page 14, line 5, immediately after "illness", by inserting
10 "or substance use disorder"; and

11 on page 14, line 25, by replacing "illness," with "illness or
12 substance use disorder,"; and

13 on page 15, line 2, immediately after the period, by inserting
14 "Medical necessity determinations for substance use disorders
15 shall be made in accordance with appropriate patient placement
16 criteria established by the American Society of Addiction
17 Medicine."; and

18 on page 15, line 7, after "illness", by inserting "and
19 substance use disorders"; and

20 on page 16, line 22, by replacing "Department" with "Department
21 of Public Health or the Department"; and

1 on page 21, by replacing line 14 with the following:

2 "categories.

3 (d) This Section shall be interpreted in a manner
4 consistent with the interim final regulations promulgated by
5 the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services at 75 FR 5410,
6 including the prohibition against applying a cumulative
7 financial requirement or cumulative quantitative treatment
8 limitation for mental, emotional, nervous, or substance use
9 disorder benefits that accumulates separately from any
10 cumulative financial requirement or cumulative quantitative
11 treatment limitation established for hospital and medical
12 benefits in the same classification.

13 (e) The provisions of subsections (b) and (c) of this
14 Section shall not be interpreted to allow the use of lifetime
15 or annual limits otherwise prohibited by State or federal
16 law."; and

17 on page 21, line 15, by replacing "(d)" with "(f)".
