The report required under this Section shall be given to the General Assembly within 30 days of when a decision is made to decrease the population of a facility by 10% or more, or in cases where population changes are due to unplanned caseload changes, within 30 days of the actual change in population by 10% or more.

Based on information contained in the reports required under this Section, the Department shall transfer funds from the facility realizing a reduction in the number of individuals served to the appropriate line item providing appropriation authority for the new venues of care, provided that the new venue of care is a Department of Human Services funded provider or facility.
