2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2189, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment
4 No. 1, on page 63, line 23 by replacing "140" with "145"; and

5 on page 64, line 14 by replacing "145" with "150"; and

6 on page 65, line 2 by replacing "150" with "160"; and

7 on page 65, line 11 by replacing "155" with "170"; and

8 on page 66, line 9 by replacing "165" with "190"; and

9 on page 66, line 22 by replacing "170" with "195"; and

10 on page 90, by replacing lines 2 through 11 with the

1 following:

2 "DIVISION OF PUBLIC AND INTERMODAL TRANSPORTATION

3 AWARDS AND GRANTS

4 Section 60. The sum of \$33,000,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation
6 Bond Series B Fund to the Department of Transportation for
7 construction costs, making grants, and providing project
8 assistance to airports pursuant to Section 34 of the Illinois
9 Aeronautics Act, as amended, for such purposes as are
10 described in the Section and for airport acquisition and
11 development pursuant to Section 72 of the Illinois
12 Aeronautics Act, as amended, for such purposes as are
13 described in that Section, without regard to the fiscal year
14 in which the service was rendered or the cost incurred.

15 Section 80. The sum of \$38,000,000, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Mass
17 Transit Trust Fund to the Department of Transportation for
18 the federal share of capital, operating, consultant services,
19 and technical assistance grants, as well as state
20 administration and interagency agreements, provided such
21 amounts shall not exceed funds to be made available from the
22 Federal Government."; and

1 on page 94, by inserting immediately after line 7 the
2 following:

3 "Section 40. The sum of \$400,046,849, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, and remains unexpended at the close of
5 business on June 30, 2011, from the reappropriation
6 heretofore made in Article 114, Section 40 of Public Act 96-
7 0956, as amended, is reappropriated from the Transportation
8 Bond Series D Fund to the Department of Transportation for
9 grants to counties, municipalities, and road districts for
10 planning, engineering, acquisition, construction,
11 reconstruction, development, improvement, extension, and all
12 construction related expenses of the public infrastructure
13 and other transportation improvement projects which are
14 related to economic development in the State of Illinois as
15 allocated in Article 50, Section 36 of Public Act 96-0956."
