SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

70 ILCS 3615/2.37 new

Amends the Regional Transportation Authority Act. Provides that no later than 120 days after the effective date of the amendatory Act, the Regional Transportation Authority must develop and make available for use by riders age 65 and over a universal fare instrument that may be used interchangeably on all public transportation funded by the Regional Transportation Authority.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Regional Transportation Authority Act is
5 amended by adding Section 2.37 as follows:

6 (70 ILCS 3615/2.37 new)

7 Sec. 2.37. Universal fare instrument for persons age 65 and
8 over. No later than 120 days after the effective date of this
9 amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly, the Authority must
10 develop and make available for use by riders age 65 and over a
11 universal fare instrument that may be used interchangeably on
12 all public transportation funded by the Authority.
