1                                    AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2915

2            AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 2915 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4            "Section 5. The Department of Central Management Services  
5 Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by  
6 changing Section 405-335 as follows:

7            (20 ILCS 405/405-335)

8            Sec. 405-335. Illinois Transparency and Accountability  
9 Portal (ITAP).

10            (a) The Department, within 12 months after the effective  
11 date of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly, shall  
12 establish and maintain a website, known as the Illinois  
13 Transparency and Accountability Portal (ITAP), with a  
14 full-time webmaster tasked with compiling and updating the ITAP  
15 database with information received from all State agencies as  
16 defined in this Section.

1 (b) For purposes of this Section:

2 "State agency" means the offices of the constitutional  
3 officers identified in Article V of the Illinois Constitution,  
4 executive agencies, and departments, boards, commissions, and  
5 Authorities under the Governor.

6 "Contracts" means payment obligations with vendors on file  
7 with the Office of the Comptroller to purchase goods and  
8 services exceeding \$10,000 in value (or, in the case of  
9 professional or artistic services, exceeding \$5,000 in value).

10 "Appropriation" means line-item detail of spending  
11 approved by the General Assembly and Governor, categorized by  
12 object of expenditure.

13 "Individual consultants" means temporary workers eligible  
14 to receive State benefits paid on a State payroll.

15 "Recipients" means State agencies receiving  
16 appropriations.

17 (c) The ITAP shall provide direct access to each of the  
18 following:

19 (1) A database of all current State employees and  
20 individual consultants, except sworn law enforcement  
21 officers, sorted separately by:

22 (i) Name.

23 (ii) Employing State agency.

24 (iii) Employing State division.

25 (iv) Employment position title.

26 (v) Current pay rate and year-to-date payL

1           including insurance benefits provided by the State.

2           (2) A database of all current State expenditures,  
3 sorted separately by agency, category, recipient, and  
4 Representative District.

5           (3) A database of all development assistance  
6 reportable pursuant to the Corporate Accountability for  
7 Tax Expenditures Act, sorted separately by tax credit  
8 category, taxpayer, and Representative District.

9           (4) A database of all revocations and suspensions of  
10 State occupation and use tax certificates of registration  
11 and all revocations and suspensions of State professional  
12 licenses, sorted separately by name, geographic location,  
13 and certificate of registration number or license number,  
14 as applicable. Professional license revocations and  
15 suspensions shall be posted only if resulting from a  
16 failure to pay taxes, license fees, or child support.

17           (5) A database of all current State contracts, sorted  
18 separately by contractor name, awarding officer or agency,  
19 contract value, and goods or services provided.

20           (6) A database of all employees hired after the  
21 effective date of this amendatory Act of 2010, sorted  
22 searchably by each of the following at the time of  
23 employment:

24                   (i) Name.

25                   (ii) Employing State agency.

26                   (iii) Employing State division.

1 (iv) Employment position title.

2 (v) Current pay rate and year-to-date pay.

3 (vi) County of employment location.

4 (vii) Rutan status.

5 (viii) Status of position as subject to collective  
6 bargaining, subject to merit compensation, or exempt  
7 under Section 4d of the Personnel Code.

8 (ix) Employment status as probationary, trainee,  
9 intern, certified, or exempt from certification.

10 (x) Status as a military veteran.

11 (7) A database of all current State grants, sorted  
12 separately by grantee name, awarding agency, grant value,  
13 and the purpose for which the grant is awarded.

14 (8) A database of all pension contributions of members  
15 of the State Employees' Retirement System of Illinois and  
16 annuity payments for annuitants under that retirement  
17 system.

18 (d) The ITAP shall include all information required to be  
19 published by subsection (c) of this Section that is available  
20 to the Department in a format the Department can compile and  
21 publish on the ITAP. The Department shall update the ITAP as  
22 additional information becomes available in a format that can  
23 be compiled and published on the ITAP by the Department.

24 (d-5) Information on the ITAP database shall be  
25 downloadable in Excel or Comma Separated Value (CSV) format.

26 (d-10) The website shall accommodate online comments and

1 questions from the public concerning State expenditures and  
2 individual expense items. The website must contain contact  
3 information for each State agency and for a list of individuals  
4 and officials who are able to answer questions about  
5 information on the website.

6 (e) Each State agency shall cooperate with the Department  
7 in furnishing the information necessary for the implementation  
8 of this Section within a timeframe specified by the Department.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January  
11 1, 2012."
