1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the
6 Department of Agriculture for County Fairs and Fair and
7 Exposition Authorities:

9 Payable from the Agricultural Premium Fund:

10	For distribution to encourage and aid	
11	county fairs and other agricultural	
12	societies.	\$1,798,600
13	For premiums to agricultural extension	
14	or 4-H clubs to be distributed at a	
15	uniform rate	786,400
16	For rehabilitation of county fairgrounds	1,850,000
17	For agricultural education programs approved by	
18	the Department of Agriculture	<u>329,300</u>
19	Total	\$4,764,300

20 Payable from Fair and Exposition Fund:

21	For distribution to County Fairs and	
22	Fair and Exposition Authorities	<u>\$900,900</u>

2 Section 10. The amount of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of
4 Agriculture from the General Revenue Fund for grants to soil
5 and water conservation districts for clerical and other
6 personnel, for education and promotional assistance, and for
7 expenses of water conservation district boards and
8 administrative expenses.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
