When a blind, hearing impaired, or physically handicapped person, mobility impaired person, a person with a 8 9 psychiatric condition, or a person who is subject to epilepsy 10 or other seizure disorders, or a person diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder is accompanied by a dog which serves 11 a guide, leader, seizure-alert, or seizure-response, 12 mobility animal, a psychiatric service animal, or autism 13 14 service dog for such person or when a trainer of a guide, 15 leader, seizure-alert, or seizure-response, mobility animal; a psychiatric service animal, or autism service 16 dog 17 accompanied by quide, leader, seizure-alert, а or seizure-response dog, mobility animal, psychiatric service, or 18 autism service dog or a dog that is being trained to be a 19 20 quide, leader, seizure-alert, or seizure-response 21 mobility, psychiatric service, or autism service dog, neither the person nor the dog shall be denied the right of entry and 22 23 use of facilities of any public place of accommodation as 24 defined in Section 5-101 of the "Illinois Human Rights Act", if

- 6 Any violation of this Act is a Class C misdemeanor.
