#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 312/7-106

5 ILCS 312/7-107

Amends the Illinois Notary Public Act. Makes it a Class 4 felony for a person to (i) knowingly perform notarial acts while not lawfully appointed and commissioned to perform those acts or (ii) knowingly act as, or otherwise impersonate, a notary public while not lawfully appointed and commissioned to perform notarial acts (now, it is a Class A misdemeanor to act as, or otherwise willfully impersonate, a notary public while not lawfully appointed and commissioned to perform notarial acts). Makes it a Class 4 felony (rather than a misdemeanor) to unlawfully possess a notary's official seal.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Notary Public Act is amended by  
5 changing Sections 7-106 and 7-107 as follows:

7 Sec. 7-106. ~~Willful~~ Impersonation. Any person who  
8 knowingly performs notarial acts while not lawfully appointed  
9 and commissioned to perform those acts or who knowingly acts  
10 as, or otherwise willfully impersonates, a notary public while  
11 not lawfully appointed and commissioned to perform notarial  
12 acts is guilty of a Class 4 felony ~~A misdemeanor.~~

15 Sec. 7-107. Wrongful Possession. Any person who unlawfully  
16 possesses a notary's official seal is guilty of a Class 4
