

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$38,650,800, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State
8 University to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal
9 year ending June 30, 2012.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$104,400, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
12 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State
13 University for awards and grants to students for the fiscal
14 year ending June 30, 2012.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
17 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Chicago State
18 University for all costs associated with the Financial
19 Assistance Outreach Center.

1 Section 20. The sum of \$307,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 3 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of
 4 Chicago State University for all costs associated with the
 5 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
 6 education or training programs.

13 University of Illinois to meet its operational expenses for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

15 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
17 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Board
18 of the Trustees of the University of Illinois to meet
19 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
20 June 30, 2012:

4 Section 15. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as
 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
 6 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
 7 Illinois for costs associated with the Hispanic Center for
 8 Excellence at the Chicago campus.

9 Section 20. The sum of \$328,300, or so much thereof as
 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
 11 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
 12 Illinois for Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

13 Section 25. The sum of \$1,250,000, or so much thereof as
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
 15 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
 16 Illinois for costs associated with the Public Policy
 17 Institute at the Chicago campus.

18 Section 30. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as
 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
 20 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
 21 Illinois for a grant to the College of Dentistry.

1 Section 35. The sum of \$3,331,200, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
3 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
4 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service
5 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the
6 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment
7 to the University for personal services and related costs
8 incurred.

9 Section 40. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
11 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
12 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
13 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

14 Section 45. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public
16 Health Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and
17 expenses related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito
18 Abatement.

19 Section 50. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire
21 Management Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and

1 expenses related to or in support of mosquito research and
2 abatement.

3 Section 55. The sum of \$425,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste
5 Research Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary
6 and contingent expenses.

7 Section 60. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
9 Professions Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
10 University of Illinois for costs associated with the
11 development, support or administration of pharmacy practice
12 education or training programs for the College of Medicine at
13 Rockford.

14 ARTICLE 13

15 Section 5. The sum of \$55,538,300, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education
17 Assistance Fund to Board of the Trustees of Western Illinois
18 University to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal
19 year ending June 30, 2012.

Section 10. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as

may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western Illinois University for scholarship grant awards from the sale of collegiate license plates.
