1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3801 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 3801 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding 4 Sections 10-10 and 10-11 as follows: 5 6 (720 ILCS 5/10-10 new) 7 Sec. 10-10. Failure to report the disappearance of a child 8 to a law enforcement agency. (a) A person commits failure to report the disappearance of 9 a child to a law enforcement agency when he or she, as a 10 parent, guardian, or other person having physical custody or 11 control of a child under 13 years of age, knowingly or 12 recklessly fails to immediately report the child as missing to 13 a law enforcement agency after a 48-hour period expires in 14 15 which he or she failed to make contact with or otherwise verify

the whereabouts and safety of that child.

1	(b) A person does not commit failure to report the
2	disappearance of a child to a law enforcement agency when the
3	failure to report is due to an act of God, act of war, or
4	inability of a law enforcement agency to receive a report of
5	the disappearance of a child.
6	(c) A person does not commit failure to report the
7	disappearance of a child to a law enforcement agency when the
8	person calls 911 to report the disappearance of the child or
9	knows that the child is under the care of another parent,
10	family member, relative, friend, or baby sitter.
11	(d) Sentence. Failure to report the disappearance of a
12	child to a law enforcement agency is a Class 4 felony.

14	Sec. 10-11. Death of a child or location of a child's
15	corpse.
16	(a) A parent, quardian, or other person having physical
17	custody or control of a child under 18 years of age must
18	report:
19	(1) the child's death to a law enforcement agency
20	within one hour after learning about the child's death; or
21	(2) the location of the child's corpse to a law
22	enforcement agency within one hour after learning the
23	location of the corpse.
24	(b) A person does not violate this Section when he or she

fails to report due to an act of God, act of war, or inability

- (c) A person does not violate this Section when he or she calls 911 to report the death of the child or if the death of the child occurs in a hospital or if the child's body is in the custody of a medical examiner or coroner, or if the death occurs in the care of a physician.
- (d) Sentence. A violation of this Section is a Class 4 8 9 felony.".
