Amends the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that "federally qualified health center" also means a health care practitioner in an individual or group practice as set forth under the federal Social Security Act. Effective July 1, 2012.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
5 changing Section 5-5.20 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-5.20)

7 Sec. 5-5.20. Clinic payments. For services provided by
8 federally qualified health centers as defined in Section 1905
9 (1)(2)(B) of the federal Social Security Act, on or after April
10 1, 1989, and as long as required by federal law, the Illinois
11 Department shall reimburse those health centers for those
12 services according to a prospective cost-reimbursement
13 methodology. For purposes of this Section, "federally
14 qualified health center" also means a health care practitioner
15 in an individual or group practice as set forth in Section
16 1902(a)(37) of the federal Social Security Act.
