SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 705/10.13 new

Amends the Illinois Police Training Act. Provides that the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board shall conduct or approve a training program that educates law enforcement officers on individuals with mental health conditions and establishes best practices for interactions with those individuals. Further provides that satisfactory completion of the program shall be evidenced by a certificate issued by the Board.

3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by
5 adding Section 10.13 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 705/10.13 new)

7 Sec. 10.13. Training; mental health conditions. The Board
8 shall conduct or approve a training program that educates law
9 enforcement officers on the identification of individuals with
10 mental health conditions and establishes best practices for
11 interactions with those individuals. Satisfactory completion
12 of the training program shall be evidenced by a certificate
13 issued to the law enforcement officer by the Board.
