1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Lory L. Price was the first motorcycle State  
3 patrolman to serve in southern Illinois; and

4 WHEREAS, Lory Price and his wife were kidnapped and  
5 murdered by the notorious Charlie Birger Gang on January 17,  
6 1927; and

7 WHEREAS, Lory Price was honored on the National Law  
8 Enforcement Memorial in Washington, D.C. for his sacrifice; and

9 WHEREAS, The bravery and dedication of Lory Price, as well  
10 as the tragic manner in which he died, should be memorialized  
11 in a befitting place and manner; therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
13 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that  
14 we designate the portion of State Highway 13 between Route 166  
15 and the Saline County line as the "Lory L. Price Memorial  
16 Highway" in honor of the service and sacrifice of Lory L.  
17 Price; and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be  
19 presented to the Williamson County Historical Society.
